This summer's **Third Annual Oregon Mahler Festival** will include two weeks of rehearsals preceding the concert which will be **Saturday July 29, 7:00pm** at **Lake Oswego High School** (2501 Country Club Rd, Lake Oswego, OR).

Mahler's 3<sup>rd</sup> Symphony is his longest, requiring a HUGE orchestra plus a women's choir and children's choir. The Sunset Presbyterian Church choir will be singing with the orchestra, as well as members of other Portland-area choirs, but additional singers (women only this year) are also invited to join in.
